# LET'S CHAT!

Before we get into the nitty gritty of a proposal, I'd love to learn more about you and what you are dreaming up. This will give us a chance to discuss all of your design options and find the suite that will be the perfect fit for your aesthetic, your timeline, and your budget.

# PROPOSAL

We will provide a detailed estimate and a timeline for the custom suite that we discuss during our initial chat. If you would like to move forward with the project, we then require a signed contract and a 50% deposit. This will reserve your slot on our design calendar. But don't worry, we can always make adjustments to your proposal up until the time the proofs are approved and sent to the printer, so if you decide to add a piece to the suite or change the quantity, it's no problem!

## INSPIRATION

Once we have a signed contract and the 50% deposit is paid, we will create a custom client page for you on our website. This will be our home base for all of our design discussion notes, inspirational images, and details about your wedding. We will also curate a custom mood board for your invitation suite that will highlight your wedding aesthetic, colors, and overall feel that we are going for to make sure that eveyone is on the same page.

# DESIGN

Our favorite part! We will start out by providing a rough sketch of our proposed design of your suite, which will include color swatches, font selections, and/or calligraphy samples for your design. Once these initial sketches are approved we will move forward with the detailed design.

We will then be in touch with digital proofs of your invitation suite, which will include the final artwork, font selections, and also show the paper/envelope selections for your suite. At this time you will be able to provide feedback for any changes that you'd like us to make. (Your custom invitation suite includes one round of revisions to the design. Any revisions beyond this will be billed at an hourly rate.) Once the final proofs are approved, a proof approval form will be required and the final payment will be due.

# PRODUCTION

Once the digital proofs are approved, the files will be submitted to the printer, and we will take it from there! Production time will vary depending on the printing method that you choose, the number of pieces in your suite, and whether or not will we be providing guest-addressing services. (We also offer invitation suite assembly services, which we would be happy to send an estimate for if this is something that would make your life easier. Otherwise, it's a great pre-marital bonding opportunity for you and your fiancé!) Your suite will then be packaged with care and shipped to you with tracking and insurance.

#### DIGITIAL PRINTING

Also known as "flat-printing", the invitation is printed in full color using a digital press. This is the most cost-effective printing option and works beautifully for designs with many colors, such as watercolor paintings.

#### LETTERPRESS PRINTING

The invitation is printed on an antique letter press, and the design is actually pressed into the paper giving the design a beautiful texture. A benefit of letterpress printing is the ability to print on extra thick paper. The down side to letterpress printing is that each color is printed separately, therefore, it is more expensive the more colors you add to your design.

#### THERMOGRAPHY PRINTING

Also knows as "raised printing", the invitation is printed using heat to make the text raise up off the paige. This is a great way to add texture to your invitation, and looks especially beautiful with metallic inks (such as gold or silver). Like letterpress printing, each color is printed separately.

#### FOIL PRINTING

The invitation is printed using gold, silver, or copper foil and is pressed into the paper (similar to letterpress printing). This gives the design a very high-gloss metallic look while also adding texture to the suite. Like letterpress and thermography printing, each color is printed separately.

We can combine any of these printing styles to create more visual interest and add more textures and colors to your suite.

#### **GUEST ADDRESSING**

Printed Guest Addresses - digitally (flat) printed

Hand-Lettered Guest Addressing\* - written with an oil-based ink pen

Calligraphy Guest Addressing\* - written with a traditional oblique pen & nib

Watercolor Guest Addressing\* - painted with a paint brush
